


- Connect a BluOS Player to Network Shares

- Before proceeding, please wait about 5-10 minutes for your Mac computer changes to be reflected across the network




- From the Player Selection Drawer, select any desired player.
- If you do have a wired Player, select that one over a wireless Player as it will have a faster response time







- If selected a share from a check box, this field is automatically filled in (and cannot be edited)
- Select Add share




- You will receive a message Share Connected and the Player will begin Indexing
- The Player itself will also indicate it is indexing via LED or front panel messaging
